The Secretariat shall have the following functions:

- a. Provide administrative support to the council;
- b. Organize and make all necessary arrangements for the council meetings;
- c. Attend council meetings;
- d. Be the central channel of communication for the council with other line units of agency, other government agencies, civil works and consulting services, and the general public.

Section IV. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14

Series of 2019

"PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE PROVINCIAL COMMITTEE ON ANTI-TRAFFICKING AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN (PCAT-VAWC), DEFINING ITS DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS."

WHEREAS, RA No. 9262 declares that the State shall give highest priority to the enactment of measures and development programs that will promote human dignity, protect the people from violence and exploitation, eliminate trafficking in persons, and mitigate pressures for involuntary migration and servitude of persons to ensure their recovery, rehabilitation and integration;

WHEREAS, RA No. 9262 underscores the commitment of the state in safeguarding the dignity of women and children while guaranteeing full respect of their human rights and to protect them from violence and threats to their personal safety and security;

WHEREAS, the two laws provide stronger mandates and direction to relevant government agencies and stakeholders to immediately address human trafficking and VAWC by organizing committee on Anti-Trafficking and VAWC at the provincial level.

NOW THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Governor of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and direct the ORGANIZATION OF THE PROVINCIAL PCAT-VAWC COMMITTEE in the Province of Occidental Mindoro.
