Section 2. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Section 2.1. CDP Technical Assessment Committee (CDP-TAC)

The CDP-TAC shall be the overall committee responsible for conducting technical activities in the assessment of CDP, including stakeholder consultations and meetings and the assessment of CDP of every component city and municipality of the Province and shall facilitate endorsement of assessment results to the PDC and the subsequent communication of these results to the concerned Municipal Development Council (MDC) for their reference and appropriate action.

Section 2.2. Technical Assessment Committee Secretariat (TACS)

The TACS shall assist in the administrative preparation, coordination and documentation of assessment results and pertinent documents for endorsement to the PDC. The TACS shall also provide other administrative support to the CDP-TAC as may be necessary.

Section 3. RELATIONSHIP WITH THE PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

The CDP-TAC shall act as a special functional committee of the PDC tasked to assess the CDPs of all component cities and municipalities of the province. All its actions shall be subject to the assessment and approval of the PDC through its Chairperson.

Section 4. SUPPORT REQUIREMENTS

The CDP-TAC may call upon the assistance of relevant units and/or LGU personnel, through the respective department heads in the implementation of various activities relative to the assessment of the CDPs.

Everyone is enjoined to participate in the various activities of the CDP-TAC as may be deemed necessary.

Section 5. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately.

**RE-ORGANIZING AND MOBILIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PLAN
TECHNICAL ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE (CDP-TAC) AND TECHNICAL ASSESSMENT
COMMITTEE SECRETARIAT (TACS) FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF THE CDPs OF
COMPONENT MUNICIPALITIES, PROVIDING FOR ITS COMPOSITION, ROLES AND
RESPONSIBILITIES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 (LGC) mandates all cities and municipalities to prepare a Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) that outlines the key goals and objectives, challenges and concerns facing local government units (LGUs) and identified a set of programs, projects and policies to attain its vision and mission towards a sustainable and holistic socio-economic development;

WHEREAS, RA 7160 further provides that the Local Development Council (LDC) is the body mandated by the LGC to prepare the multi-sectoral development plan of an LGU, thus it is critical to ensure that the LDC as well as its functional and sectoral committees, as providers of technical support and assistance are constituted and activated including the technical working group for that purpose;

WHEREAS, DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No.1, series of 2016 (JMC No. 2016-1) entitled Updated Guidelines on the Harmonization of Local Planning Performance Monitoring and Coordination in Fiscal Oversight, issued on 18 November 2016, provides that the shared oversight function of the province over its component cities and municipalities shall be strengthened through the development and implementation of tools to ensure compliance of component LGUs with established policies and guidelines on Public Financial Management (PFM);

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular 2018-172 *Comprehensive Development Plan Assessment for Component Cities and Municipalities* provides that the Provincial Development Council (PDC) through a Special Functional Committee created for the purpose, shall assess the CDPs of its component cities and municipalities for compliance with established guidelines on the formulation of the CDP; it's alignment with the Provincial Development and Physical Framework Plan (PDPFP), Provincial Development Investment Plan (PDIP), Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP); and, to national development thrusts and strategic directions as part of the provinces shared oversight function with concerned national agencies;

NOW THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Governor of Occidental Mindoro, and the Chairperson of the PDC by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby re-organize and mobilize the **"CDP TECHNICAL ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE (CDP-TAC)"** as a special functional committee of the PDC, to wit:
