EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 47

Series of 2019

AN ORDER MANDATING SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS, BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE, AND WORK IN ALL OFFICES, BOTH LOCAL AND NATIONAL AND PRIVATE ON DECEMBER 3, 2019 (TUESDAY) IN THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO, AS PRE-EMPTIVE MEASURE IN ANTICIPATION OF THE DISRUPTIVE EFFECTS OF TYPHOON TISOY(ICN. KAMMURI).

WHEREAS, the Province of Occidental Mindoro is directly in the path of Typhoon "TISOY" (ICN: KAMMURI), when it entered PAR at 4:00 PM, 30 November 2019 and as included in Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal #2 as of December 2, 2019 at 8:00AM;

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Provincial Government to ensure the safety and welfare of the people of Occidental Mindoro, pursuant to the General Welfare Clause of RA 7160 (the Local Government Code 1991);

WHEREAS, in anticipation of the disruptive effects as may be caused by the approaching severeweather disturbance, the safety and protection of all vulnerable sectors, especially school children, are of paramount concern;

WHEREAS, during the Pre Disaster Risk Assessment for Typhoon "TISOY", it was unanimously recommended by the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (PDRRMC) to suspend classes in all levels, both public and private; and office work, local and national, and private offices in anticipation of disastrous effects of TY TISOY;

THEREFORE, I,EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Provincial Governor, by virtue of the powers vested inme by Section 465 (b) (2) (iii), Article 1, Chapter 3, Book of RA7160, do hereby order the suspension of classes in all levels, both public and private, and work in offices, local and national and private on December 3, 2019 in the entire Province of Occidental Mindoro, as pre-emptive measures in anticipation of the disruption as may be caused by Typhoon "TISOY" (ICN: KAMMURI).
