- b. Dine-in service in food retail establishments such as supermarkets, grocery stores, and food preparation establishments, at a maximum of fifty percent (50%) operational capacity.
- c. Other Category IV and all other establishments not permitted to operate under previous Sections of these Guidelines, at a maximum of fifty percent (50%) operational capacity.

Section 12. WORK IN GOVERNMENT OFFICES.

Work in government offices may be at full operational capacity, or under such alternative work arrangements as agencies may deem appropriate in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations issued by the Civil Service Commission (CSC).

Section 13. PROVISIONS OF OMNIBUS GUIDELINES ADOPTED.

Guidelines for interzonal and intrazonal movement and the General Provisions as provided under Sections 7 and 8 of the IATF Omnibus Guidelines and its all other provisions are hereby adopted insofar as these are applicable to the implementation of Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ).

Section 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid for any reason, the parts not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

Section 15. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations issued by this province which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

Section 16. EFFECTIVITY.

This ORDER shall be in full force and effect during the modified general community quarantine period (June 1, 2020 to June 15, 2020), unless earlier repealed or extended by another issuance.

Section 6. LIMITED MASS GATHERINGS.

Mass gatherings such as but not limited to, movie screenings, concerts, sporting events, and other entertainment activities, community assemblies, and non-essential work gatherings shall be allowed provided that participants shall be limited to fifty percent (50%) of the venue or seating capacity. Religious gatherings shall be allowed under such guidelines as may be declared through subsequent issuances of the IATF.

Section 7. CLASSES IN HEIs and K-12 BASIC EDUCATION.

Face-to-face or in-person classes may be conducted in HEIs provided there is strict compliance with minimum public health standards, consultation with local government units, and compliance with guidelines set by CHED. HEI activities that involve mass gathering of students shall continue to be prohibited.

For K-12 Basic Education, the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan of the DepEd shall be adopted.

Section 8. WORK IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE OFFICES.

Work in all public and private offices may be allowed to resume physical reporting to work at full operating capacity, with alternative work arrangements for persons who are sixty (60) years old and above, those with immunodeficiency, comorbidity, or other health risks, and pregnant women.

Section 9. PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TRANSPORTATION.

The road, rail, maritime, and aviation sectors of public transportation shall be allowed to operate at the capacity in accordance with guidelines issued by the DOTr. Provided, that in all public transports, a strict one (1) meter distance between passengers shall be observed and appropriate engineering controls shall be in place.

Private transportation shall be allowed subject to the guidelines provided by DOTr.

Section 10. PUBLIC AND PRIVATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

All public and private construction projects shall be allowed subject to strict compliance with the construction safety guidelines issued by the DPWH for the implementation of infrastructure projects during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Section 11. ESTABLISHMENTS AND ACTIVITIES ALLOWED TO OPERATE.

All permitted establishments and activities under Category I-IV of Section 4(6) of the IATF Omnibus Guidelines dated May 22, 2020, shall be allowed to operate or be undertaken at full operational capacity, except as otherwise provided below:

- a. Barber shops, salons, and other personal care service establishments, at a maximum of fifty percent (50%) operational capacity;



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WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, there is an urgent need to promulgate this Executive Order to provide guidelines and procedures for the implementation of Modified General Community Quarantine in certain municipalities of the Province of Occidental Mindoro from June 1, 2020 until June 15, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Governor, Province of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (MGCQ).

Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) refers to the transition phase between GCQ and New Normal, when the following temporary measures are relaxed and become less necessary: limiting movement and transportation, the regulation of operating industries, and the presence of uniformed personnel to enforce community quarantine protocols.

Section 2. MUNICIPALITIES COVERED BY MGCQ.

The Municipalities of Mamburao, Sta. Cruz, Paluan, Abra de Ilog, Lubang and Looc are placed under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) and are covered by this Executive Order starting June 1, 2020 until June 15, 2020.

Section 3. MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS.

Minimum public health standards shall be complied with at all times for the duration of the MGCQ.

Minimum public health standards refers to guidelines set by the DOH in Administrative Order No. 2020-0015, as well as sector-relevant guidelines issued by national government agencies as authorized by the IATF, to aid all sectors in all settings to implement non-pharmaceutical interventions (NPI), which refer to public health measures that do not involve vaccines, medications or other pharmaceutical interventions, which individuals and communities can carry out in order to reduce transmission rates, contact rates, and the duration of infectiousness of individuals in the population to mitigate COVID-19.

Section 4. PERSONS ALLOWED TO GO OUTSIDE RESIDENCES.

All persons shall now be allowed to go outside their residences. However, they shall wear face masks and observe physical distancing while outside their residences.

Section 5. ALLOWED SPORTS ACTIVITIES AND EXERCISES.

Indoor and outdoor non-contact sports and other forms of exercise such as but not limited to walking, jogging, running, biking, golf, swimming, tennis, badminton, equestrian, and skateboarding are allowed. Provided, that the minimum public health standards such as wearing of masks and the maintenance of social distancing protocols, and no sharing of equipment where applicable, are observed.

“GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (MGCQ) STARTING JUNE 1, 2020 TO JUNE 15, 2020 IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES OF THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO”

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, on April 30, 2020, Executive Order No. 112 Series of 2020 was issued imposing an Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) in high-risk geographic areas of the Philippines and a General Community Quarantine (GCQ) in the rest of the country from May 1 to May 15, 2020, adopting the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation thereof, and for other purposes;

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases issued Resolution No. 29 Series of 2020 removing the Province of Occidental Mindoro from the list of provinces under Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) and instead it was placed under General Community Quarantine (GCQ) starting May 1, 2020 to May 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, pursuant to IATF Resolution No. 29 Series of 2020, the Provincial Government issued Executive Order No. 60 Series of 2020 entitled “Guidelines and Procedures for the Implementation of General Community Quarantine (GCQ) starting May 1, 2020 to May 15, 2020 in the Province of Occidental Mindoro”;

WHEREAS, IATF Resolution No. 36 Series of 2020 was issued providing that beginning May 16, 2020, provinces, HUCs, ICCs previously classified as low-risk under IATF Resolution No. 35, including the Province of Occidental Mindoro, shall be placed under General Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, the IATF issued Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines dated May 22, 2020;

WHEREAS, in IATF Resolution No. 40 Series of 2020 dated May 27, 2020, the Province of Occidental Mindoro is classified among the low-risk provinces in Luzon thereby placing it under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) starting June 1, 2020 until June 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, due to the letters-appeal of some municipalities of the province which were endorsed by the Provincial Governor to the Regional Inter-Agency Task Force (RITF) on May 28, 2020, the RIATF issued a Resolution concurring on placing the Municipalities of San Jose, Sablayan, Calintaan and Rizal under General Community Quarantine (GCQ) and the Municipality of Magsaysay under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) starting June 1, 2020 until June 15, 2020;
