RESOLUTION No. 03 Series of 2020

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FY 2021 GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN AND BUDGET OF THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO.

WHEREAS, RA9710, otherwise known as Magna Carta of Women Act and its implementing rules and regulations mandated all local government units to mainstream Gender and Development (GAD) in local policy-making, planning, programming, budgeting, implementation, monitoring and evaluation;

WHEREAS, consequently, PCW-DBM-DILG-NEDA Joint Memorandum Circular 2013-1, mandated the allocation of funds of at least five percent (5%) of the total annual budget of the LGUs for GAD-related programs, projects, and activities (PPAs);

WHEREAS, 2021 Gender and Development Plan and Budget of Occidental Mindoro is a product of series of trainings and workshops, and the PPAs identified therein were formulated to address the gaps on gender equality and development in the province.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, on motion of MPDC Jesus Jonjie Venturanza representative of the mayor of Magsaysay, and duly seconded by MPDC Randy Ramos, representative of the mayor of Rizal, the Provincial Development Council hereby approves the FY 2021 Gender and Development of the province Occidental Mindoro.
