# AN ORDER PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE PEACE AND ORDER AND PUBLIC SAFETY (POPS) PLAN TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) FOR THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO

WHEREAS, Section 116 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates the Local Government Units (LGUs) to establish in every province, city and municipality a local peace and order council, pursuant to Executive Order Numbered Three hundred nine (E.O. No. 309), as amended, Series of 1988. On January 5, 2009, the President of the Republic of the Philippines promulgated Executive No. 773, further reorganizing the peace and order council;

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2019, Governor Eduardo B. Gadiano signed Executive Order No. 9, series of 2019, providing for the reorganization/amendment of the Provincial Peace and Order Council (PPOC) of Occidental Mindoro;

WHEREAS, as provided under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-143 or the Omnibus Guidelines for Peace and Order Councils (POCs) dated August 27, 2019, it is among the duties and functions of the Provincial Peace and Order Council (PPOC) to create a Technical Working Group for the purpose of POPS Planning following the guidelines prescribed by the aforementioned Omnibus Guidelines and such other DILG issuances on the tools and processes on POPS Planning;

NOW THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Governor of the Province of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the CREATION OF THE PEACE AND ORDER AND PUBLIC SAFETY (POPS) PLAN TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) FOR THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO.

### **SECTION 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF POPS PLAN TWG.** The POPS PLAN TWG shall exercise the following functions:

- a. Lead in the formulation of POPS Plan;
- b. Prepare documents that could serve as reference for the profiling of the strategic direction and peace and order and public safety issues in the locality;
- Conduct data gathering and stakeholder consultations as needed and analyze data gathered;
- d. Coordinate with communities or barangays for data-gathering and action planning for the implementation of POPS Plan;
- e. Coordinate with POC Sub-Committee Heads relative to the recommended PPSAs for inclusion in the POP Plan:
- f. In coordination with the POC Chair and Secretariat Head, convene the POC and present the POPS Plan for discussion, approval, and appropriate action;
- g. Present data to the POC for prioritization of issues and development of strategies;

- h. Draft and finalize the POPS Plan;
- In coordination with the Mayor, convene the POC and present the POPS Plan for discussion, approval, and appropriate action;
- j. Take part in the submission and SP adoption of the POPS Plan;
- k. Encode the approved POPS Plan in the POPSP-PCMS;
- Coordinate with internal and external stakeholders for effective communication and monitoring as laid out in the POPS Plan;
- m. Ensure inclusion of key programs or strategies (DILG MC No. 2015-128, Annex 3) CSOP, and conflict-sensitivity, if deemed appropriate, in the POPS Plan; and
- n. Submit the following reports:
  - a. Semestral accomplishment report, submit not later than 15<sup>th</sup> day of August for 1<sup>st</sup> semester and 15<sup>th</sup> day of March for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester;
  - b. Annual report, not later than 15<sup>th</sup> day of March.
- o. Perform such other tasks as may be directed by the council.

**SECTION 3. MEETINGS.** A quarterly meeting is to be held regularly. The body shall hold meetings on the last Monday of the month of every quarter.

#### **SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.**

If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid for any reason, the parts not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

#### SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations issued by this province which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
