AN ORDER DESIGNATING A DISASTER RISK REDUCTION IN MANAGEMENT IN HEALTH (DRRM-H) MANAGER AND ASSISTANT MANAGER FOR THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR FUNCTIONS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Republic Act 11223 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations supports the institutionalization of the Disaster Risk Reduction in Management in Health (DRRM-H) System which call for strengthening the local health system's capacities not just in responding to emergencies/disaster but in the whole spectrum of DRRM;

WHEREAS, DOH also issued Administrative Order No. 2019-0046 on the National Policy on Disaster Risk Reduction and Management in Health and Administrative Order No. 2020-0036 on the Guidelines on the Institutionalization of DRRM-H in Province-wide or City-wide Health Systems;

WHEREAS, as the country's COVID-19 experience teaches us, the Disaster Risk Reduction in Management in Health (DRRM-H) System proves to be a crucial element in creating resilient and sustainable communities, hence, the imperative need to institutionalize it in the province of Occidental Mindoro.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO**, Governor of the Province of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF DISASTER RISK REDUCTION IN MANAGEMENT IN HEALTH (DRRM-H) MANAGER AND ASSISTANT MANAGER. The following personnel are hereby designated for the following positions, to wit:

- ENGR. ARMANDO C. ALCAIDE- DRRM-H Manager
- JOHN TRYANN S. TRIA- DRRM-H Assistant Manager

## SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS OF DRRM-H MANAGER.

- A. The Provincial DRRM-H Manager shall perform the following functions:
  - Report directly and coordinate to the Provincial Health Officer for DRRM- Systems development.
  - 2. Maintain an open and accessible line of communication at all times especially during emergencies and disasters.
  - Lead managerial, technical and facilitate financial integration of a functional DRRM-H System in the Province Wide Health System (PWHS) and lobby for the necessary support:
    - Lead in the development, integration, dissemination of PWHS DRRM-H Plan in coordination with the health sub-cluster focal points.
    - Organize and coordinate health emergency response teams and manage its mobilization and deployment.

- c. Manage and mobilize health emergency commodities, including strategic prepositioning and warehousing.
- d. Establish health emergency information system and adopt the reporting system of the Department of Health and coordinate with the Regional Operations Center in monitoring all health events, emergencies and disasters.
- e. Coordinate budget and planning of DRRM-H funds as approved by the LCE or the Provincial Health Board.
- 4. Ensure compliance with the latest standards on DRRM-H.
- Strengthen operations and coordinate implementation of delivery of essential health services- Public Health/Medical to include Minimum Initial Service Package for Sexual and Reproductive Health (MISP for SRH), Nutrition in Emergencies, Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH), and Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS), and participate in the health system recovery and rehabilitation efforts.
- 6. Facilitate and participate in DRRM-H capacity and capability building activities.
  - a. Lead in the development and preparation of the system to address health hazards and risks;
  - b. Oversee the learning and development activities for all DRRM-H staff.
- 7. Promote and advocate DRRM-H and build resilience through various applicable and accessible platforms.
- Implement mechanisms to monitor and evaluate initiatives on the program and report progress and facilitate the development of research and/or proposals on DRRM-H.
- 9. Establish network and form partnerships with PWHS members maintain synchronized operation and coordination activities with other instrumentalities pursuant to NDRRMC Circular and Republic Act 10121).

**SECTION 3. FUNCTIONS OF ASSISTANT DRRM-H MANAGER.** The Provincial Assistant DRRM-H Manager shall be tasked to perform the following functions:

- 1. Assist the Provincial DRRM-H manager in all above-specified roles and responsibilities and act as substitute in his/her absence.
- 2. Facilitate submission of reports and other related documents as required by the Provincial Health office, Department of Health Center for Health Development and Central office and other partner agencies.
- 3. Facilitate the conduct of learning and development needs assessment and ensure that capability development needs of DRRM-H personnel and other stakeholders including adopted community DRRM-H workers are addressed.

**Section 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid for any reason, the parts not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

**Section 5. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations issued by this province which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.



SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
