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EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 30-A
Series of 2022

AN ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 30, SERIES OF 2022, BY UPDATING THE COMPOSITION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PROVINCIAL TOURISM MASTER PLAN REVIEW COMMITTEE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9593 or Tourism Act of 2009 was enacted "Declaring a national policy for tourism as an engine of investment, employment growth and national development, and strengthening the Department of Tourism and its attached agencies to effectively and efficiently implement that policy, and appropriating funds therefor;"

WHEREAS, the Province of Occidental Mindoro is endowed with resources from where viable tourism products may be anchored on.

WHEREAS, realizing that unplanned tourism may result to irreversible environmental and social impacts, the Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro commits to invest in a master planning initiative to put tourism along the sustainable path.

WHEREAS, to enable the Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro and the private sector to undertake measures in developing the master plan initiative for the tourism of the province, there is a need to create a body that shall be in-charge of the transmission of documents, discussion and assessment of the merits and completeness of the requirements, issuance of recommendation and submission of regular reports on the progress of the Provincial Tourism Master Plan.

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, Executive Order No. 30, series of 2022 was enacted creating and establishing the Provincial Tourism Master Plan Review Committee;

WHEREAS, there is a need for an amendment of the abovementioned Executive Order to modify and update the members of the said Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Governor of the Province of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. CREATION.

It is hereby created under the Provincial Governor's Office, a Review Committee to be called Provincial Tourism Master Plan Review Committee. The Review Committee shall be responsible for the transmission of the documents, discussion and assessment of merit and completeness of the requirements, issuance of recommendation, submission of regular reports, and other matters concerning the Tourism Master Plan of the province of Occidental Mindoro.



SECTION 2. COMPOSITION.

For provincial level deliverables which include Heritage Mapping Report, Provincial Situational Analysis Report, Provincial Trail and Reef Assessment Report, Framework Plan, Product Manual and Marketing Plan, and Site Development Plan, the committee shall be composed of the following members:

Ma. Lucila B. Hernandez	- Provincial Tourism Office (Lead)
Anthony A. Dantis	- Provincial Planning and Development Office
Carla Azalea A. Abanilla	- Provincial Accounting Office
Atty. Tirso Augustus L. Abeleda II	- Provincial Legal Office

For municipal level deliverables, which include Tourism Master Plan, Business Plans, and Site Development Plan, the committee shall be composed of *municipal tourism officers of all the municipalities of the province.*

In addition to the abovementioned members, the Committee may also create an Organization that will act as an oversight and lobby group for the industry, and to oversee the implementation of the plans on the provincial level.

SECTION 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS.

The Committee shall have the following duties and functions:

- Within three (3) days from the submission of output/deliverable related to the Occidental Mindoro Tourism Master Planning initiative, the lead shall transmit the documents to the members of the review committee;
- Ten (10) days thereafter, the lead shall convene the committee to discuss the merit and completeness of the output/deliverables and assess if the same meets the requirements as stated in the contract;
- Three (3) days after the committee meeting, the lead shall issue recommendation to the Governor;
- Upon the approval of the Governor, the lead shall facilitate the processing of payment in accordance with the terms of reference;
- Submit to the Governor regularly progress report on the physical and financial status of the Tourism Master Plan and such other reports as may be required.
- Perform other functions as may be deemed necessary or as required for the development of the Tourism Master Plan of the province.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any section or provision of this Order is held unconstitutional or invalid, any other section or provision not affected thereby shall remain valid and effective.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All orders, rules and regulations issued by the Provincial Government which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until expressly revoked.
