

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 37 Series of 2022

"RECONSTITUTION OF THE PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL OF THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO, DEFINING ITS DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS AND FOR OTHER **PURPOSES**"

WHEREAS, Section 106 of the Local Government Code provides that "Each local government unit shall have a comprehensive multi-sectoral development plan to be initiated by its development council and approved by its sanggunian. For this purpose, the development council at the provincial, city, municipal, or barangay level, shall assist the corresponding sanggunian in setting the direction of economic and social development, and coordinating development efforts within its territorial jurisdiction.";

WHEREAS, there is an imperative need to reconstitute the Provincial Development Council of Occidental Mindoro due to changes in its composition in view of election and appointment of other officials.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Governor of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and direct the reconstitution of the Provincial Development Council of Occidental Mindoro:

Section 1. Composition. The Provincial Development Council of the Province of Occidental Mindoro shall be composed of the following:

The above-named representatives of Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) shall continue to be members of the council in an interim capacity until the accreditation process of chosen CSOs is consummated.

Section 2. Duties of the Council. The Provincial Development Council shall have the following duties and functions:

- a. Formulate the long-term, medium-term and annual socio-economic development plans and policies of the province;
- b. Formulate the medium-term and annual investment plan of the province;
- c. Appraise and prioritize socio-economic development programs and projects;
- d. Formulate local investment incentives to promote the inflow and direction of the private investment capital;
- e. Coordinate, monitor and evaluate the implementation of development programs and projects; and
- f. Perform such other functions as may be provided by law or competent authority.

Section 3. Meetings and Quorums. The Provincial Development Council shall meet at least once every six (6) months or as often as may be necessary.

Section 4. Executive Committee.

a. The Provincial Development Council shall create an Executive Committee to represent it and act on its behalf when it is not in session. The composition of the Executive Committee shall be as follows:

The Governor as the Chairman, Representative of the Municipal Mayors, Chairman of Committee on Appropriation of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, the President of the Association of Barangay Captains, and a representative of NGO's as members.

- b. The Executive Committee shall exercise the following powers and functions:
 - 1. Ensure that the decision of the council is faithfully carried out and implemented:
 - 2. Act on matters requiring immediate attention or action by the council;
 - 3. Formulate policies, plan and programs based on the general principles laid down by the council;
 - 4. Act on other matters that may be authorized by the council.

Section 5. Sectoral Functional Committees. The Provincial Council may form Functional Committees as provided by Section 112 of the Local Government Code to assist the Provincial Development Council in the performance of its functions.


Section 6. Secretariat. There is hereby constituted for the Provincial Development Council a secretariat which shall be responsible for providing technical support, documentation of proceedings, preparation of reports and such other assistance as may be required in the discharge of its functions. The Provincial Development Council may avail the services of any NGO or educational or research institutions for this purpose, and shall be headed by the Provincial Planning Coordinator. A representative from Occidental Mindoro State College (OMSC) and Provincial Planning Officers shall be its members.

Section 7. Relation of the Provincial Development Council to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and the Regional Development Council. The policies, programs, and projects proposed shall be submitted to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for appropriate action.

The local development plans approved by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan may be integrated with the development plans of the Regional Development Council for submission to the National Economic and Development Authority, in accordance with the existing laws.

Section 8. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid for any reason, the parts not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

Section 9. Repealing Clause. All Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations issued by this province which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.



Section 10. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
