AN ORDER PROVIDING FOR THE REORGANIZATION OF THE PROVINCIAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (PDRRMC) IN THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010", declares it as the policy of the State to uphold the people's constitutional rights to life and property by addressing the root causes of vulnerabilities to disasters, strengthening the capacity for disaster risk reduction and management, and building resilience of local communities to disasters including climate change impacts;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11 of Republic Act No. 10121, Local Government Units (LGUs) are enjoined to create Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC) in their respective jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", mandates LGUs to adopt measures to protect inhabitants the adverse effects of manmade or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance to the victims during and in the aftermath of such disasters and calamities and their return to productive livelihood after the said events;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 03, Series of 2019 provides for the creation of Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (PDRRMC) in the Province of Occidental Mindoro in compliance with the mandates of the aforementioned statute;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 03-A, series of 2020 was issued to change the composition of PDRRMC;

WHEREAS, there is need to further reorganize the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council of Occidental Mindoro to update its composition;

NOW THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Governor of the Province of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the REORGANIZATION OF THE PROVINCIAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (PDRRMC) IN THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PDRRMC. The PDRRMC shall perform the following functions and responsibilities:

- (1) Approve, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Provincial Disaster Risk Management Plan and regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and provincial planning programs;
- (2) Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into provincial development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;
- (3) Recommend the implementation of forced or preemptive evacuation of local residents, if necessary;
- (4) Convene once every three (3) months or as necessary; and
- (5) Perform tasks as may be called for by the Provincial Governor in the event of calamities or disasters.

SECTION 3. Secretariat and PDRRMO. There shall be a Secretariat and Staff to the PDRRMO headed by the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer to perform the following functions, duties and responsibilities:

- a) Provide technical support to the PDRRMO in the formulation, initiation and the implementation of its plans and programs for consideration by the council;
- Provide secretariat support during regular meeting of the PDRRMO, schedules and calls emergency meetings, conferences and does regular coordination with the MDRRMO in the province;
- Render reports to the PDRRMO relative to the proposed activities of the MDRRMO, propose consolidated or integrated approach to implement Disaster Plans Programs after approval by the proper authorities concerned;
- d) Establish direct linkages between barangays, municipal, national agencies, nongovernment sectors and offices directly or indirectly responsible for disaster and risk reduction operations in the province;
- e) Formulate policies and guidelines for the Governor thru the PDRRMO that would govern risk reduction operation and related activities in the province;
- Present to the Provincial Governor thru the PDRRMO, the projects that are prioritized for implementation taking into consideration the resources and capacity of the implementing agency/ies involved;



- g) Formulate and present proposals out of the consolidated proposals submitted by the municipalities for all risk reduction and disaster rehabilitation management programs;
- h) Prepare and conduct continuous training modules for emergency rescue operations; and
- i) Perform other duties, functions and responsibilities as may be called for by the Governor for all risk reduction related activities in Occidental Mindoro.

SECTION 4. Administrative Support. Whenever needed or requested, all concerned agencies in the provincial government through heads of departments are hereby enjoined to provide technical and administrative support in the implementation of this Order.

SECTION 5. FUNDS. Funding as may be required for the implementation of this Order shall be properly charged against the funds appropriated to the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office sourced from the budgetary allocation for the year. Non-Government Sector may provide voluntary funding assistance for projects in support to the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management program of the province.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid for any reason, the parts not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. All Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations issued by this province which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
