

# EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 54

Series of 2022

AN ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 21 SERIES OF 2019, AS AMENDED BY EXECUTIVE ORDER 21-A SERIES OF 2020, BY UPDATING THE NAMES OF MEMBERS OF THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL FOR CULTURE AND ARTS (PCCA), AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Provincial Governor promulgated Executive Order No. 21 Series of 2019 entitled "Providing for the Reorganization of the Provincial Council for Culture and the Arts (PCCA) of the Province of Occidental Mindoro, Defining its Duties, Functions, Appropriating Funds Therefor and for other Purposes";

WHEREAS, the Provincial Governor promulgated Executive Order No. 21-A Series of 2020 amending Executive Order No. 21 Series of 2019 entitled "Amendment of Executive Order No. 21 Series of 2019 By Updating the Name of Member of the Provincial Council for Culture and the Arts (PCCA), the Members of the Secretariat and Providing for the Duties and Functions of the Secretariat and for Other Purposes";

**WHEREAS**, several members of the Provincial Council for Culture and the Arts were either retired, promoted, transferred to another office or whose tenure of office have already ended;

**WHEREAS**, in view of the foregoing, there is a need to promulgate this Executive Order to update the names of the members of the PCCA;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO**, Governor of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and direct the following:

**Section 1**. Section II of Executive Order No. 21 Series of 2019, as amended by Section 1 of Executive Order No. 21-A, is hereby further amended to read as follows:





Section 2. Functions. The functions of the Culture and the Arts Council are as follows:

As per DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2002-81 or The Creation of Local Culture and the Arts Council:

- a. Prepare an annual plan on culture, arts, and cultural heritage consonant with the Philippine Development Plan for Culture and the Arts, to be integrated in the local development plan and considered in the annual appropriation ordinances;
- Formulate programs and recommendations to develop and sustain local cultural and artistic talents, cultural industries, traditional and contemporary arts and crafts, and their processes;
- Coordinate with the appropriate affiliated cultural agencies of the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) for the conservation and monitoring of national cultural properties found in the LGU;
- d. Conduct cultural events such as cultural festivals, competition, lectures, seminars and symposia;
- e. Identify such other programs and activities for the promotion of local cultural heritage and arts;


As per Republic Act No. 10066 or The National Cultural Heritage Act of 2009:

- f. Ensure the protection, preservation, conservation and promotion of the local cultural and historical heritage;
- g. Declare and maintain Local Heritage Zones;
- h. Establish a Local Registry of Cultural Property;

As per Republic Act No. 7355 or The Gawad ng Manlilikha ng Bayan Act:

- i. Acknowledge the importance of traditional folk artist as singular conduit between skills of the past and the future;
- Revitalize a community's artistic tradition thereby protecting a valuable fact of Philippine culture;
- k. Provide mechanisms for identification and assistance for qualified traditional folk artists to transfer their skills to the community; and,
- I. Create opportunities for popularizing their works locally.

**Section 3. Separability Clause.** If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid for any reason, the parts not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.



**Section 4. Repealing Clause.** All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

Section 5. Effectivity Clause. This order shall take effect immediately.
