

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 39

Series of 2022

"AN ORDER MANDATING ALL MUNICIPAL LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS (MLGUs) TO ANNUALLY COMMEMORATE, IN UNISON WITH THE CELEBRATION OF THE FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY OF THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO"

WHEREAS, Republic Act 11123, series of 2018, declared November 15 every year as a special non-working holiday in the Province of Occidental Mindoro in commemoration of its Founding Anniversary;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro is aiming for the success of the yearly celebration of its Founding Anniversary;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro acknowledges the valuable participation of each Municipal Local Government Units (MLGUs) of the Province;

NOW THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Governor of the Province of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order all Municipal Local Government Units (MLGUS) to annually commemorate, in unison with the celebration of the Founding Anniversary of the Province of Occidental Mindoro;

Section 1. Creating Plans to Celebrate the Founding Anniversary within the Respective Municipalities or in Collaboration with the Provincial Local Government Unit (PLGU). Enjoining all Municipal Local Government Units (MLGUs) to plan a Program, showing support in commemorating the celebration of the Founding Anniversary, by means of either collaborating with the province or creating/planning programs within their respective municipalities;

Section 2. Separability. If any part of this order is held unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Repealing Clause. All prior orders, rules, regulations, and issuances or parts thereof, issued by the Province, that are inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
