

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 86 Series of 2020

AN ORDER MANDATING SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE, AND WORK IN ALL LOCAL, NATIONAL AND PRIVATE OFFICES ON OCTOBER 26, 2020 (MONDAY) IN THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO, AS PRE-EMPTIVE MEASURE IN ANTICIPATION OF THE

DISRUPTIVE EFFECTS OF TY "QUINTA" (ICN: MOLAVE).

WHEREAS, the Province of Occidental Mindoro is directly in the path of Typhoon "QUINTA" (ICN: MOLAVE), when it entered PAR at 2:00 PM, 23 October 2020 and as included in the Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal #2 as of October 25, 2020 at 11:00 AM;

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Provincial Government to ensure the safety and welfare of the people of Occidental Mindoro, pursuant to the General Welfare Clause of RA7160 (the Local Government Code 1991);

WHEREAS, in anticipation of the disruptive effects as may be caused by the approaching severe weather disturbance, the safety and protection of all vulnerable sectors, are of paramount concern;

THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Provincial Governor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 465 (b) (2) (iii), Article 1, Chapter 3, Book of RA7160, do hereby order the suspension of classes in all levels both public and private, and work in local, national and private offices on October 26, 2020 in the entire Province of Occidental Mindoro, as pre-emptive measures in anticipation of the disruption as may be caused by Typhoon "QUINTA" (ICN: MOLAVE).

However, agencies whose functions are directly involved in delivery of basic and health services, disaster preparedness and response and those performing other vital services are not covered by this Order and shall continue with their operations.
