



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 89
Series of 2020

**"AN ORDER CREATING THE PROVINCIAL POVERTY REDUCTION ACTION TEAM (PPRAT)
FOR THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO, DEFINING ITS DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"**

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM), the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) and the National Anti-Poverty Commission (NAPC) issued Joint Memorandum Circular No. 7 on November 3, 2015 entitled "Policy Guidelines and Procedures in the Implementation of Bottom-Up Budgeting Program for FY 2016 and Thereafter".

WHEREAS, BuBP is an approach to formulating the budget proposal of national gov't agencies, taking into consideration the development needs of poor cities/municipalities as identified in their respective local poverty reduction action plans that shall be formulated with strong participation of basic sectors and civil society organizations.

WHEREAS, as a national strategy, the Human Development and Poverty Reduction Cluster (HDPRC) organized under E.O. No. 43 s. 2011, together with the DBM and the DILG shall pilot the bottom-up approach in planning and budgeting and ensure the inclusion of the funding requirements for the development needs of at least 300 from the 609 selected focused local government units (LGUs) as identified and approved by the HDPRC in the budget proposals of participating national government agencies.

WHEREAS, the program thrusts in the Poverty Strategy and the Anti-Poverty Localization and Participation Framework is focused on: a) poorest of the poor; b) people's participation and empowerment; and c) rationalization of poverty reduction programs;

WHEREAS, people's participation is greatly encouraged in this initiative to introduce governance reforms that will make the planning and budgeting processes of government more participatory through the genuine involvement of grassroots organizations and communities.

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, there is an imperative need to promulgate this Executive Order to create the Provincial Poverty Reduction Action Team (PPRAT) for the Province of Occidental Mindoro.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Governor of the Province of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the creation of the Provincial Poverty Reduction Action Team (PPRAT):

SECTION 1. CREATION. The Provincial Poverty Reduction Action Team (PPRAT) is hereby created. It shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS OF THE PROVINCIAL POVERTY REDUCTION ACTION TEAM (PPRAT).

1. Organize the Technical Working Group and Secretariat;
2. Spearhead the formulation and monitoring of the Provincial Poverty Reduction Action Plan (PPRAP);
3. Conduct a PPRAP workshop to formulate a Provincial Poverty Reduction Action Plan based on relevant economic and social data, as well as feedback from the members of the PPRAT;
4. Ensure active participation of CSOs, basic sector representatives and other non-government stakeholders as they shall help validate data and analysis that will be presented by the LGU;
5. Invite concerned Agency Regional Offices (AROs) to the workshop to provide information on the programs of their respective agencies and to provide technical assistance in the formulation of the PPRAP. The PPRAP shall identify a poverty reduction strategy to be undertaken by the LGU and other stakeholders;
6. Identify priority poverty reduction projects to be funded by the LGUs and projects which will be submitted to national agencies for consideration in their budget.

SECTION 3. SCOPE OF THE PROVINCIAL POVERTY REDUCTION ACTION TEAM (PPRAT).

1. Harmonization of the PPPs of the Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro anchored on Sambayanihan of NAPC;
2. Providing template of pilot municipalities for implementation of village eco-governance development framework for the Sambarangayan;

3. Implementation of Ka-Sambayanihan volunteer program involving NGAs and the private sector;
4. Mobilization of logistics and financial requirements;
5. Formulation of provincial development framework.

SECTION 4. SECRETARIAT.

There shall be a Secretariat for the Provincial Poverty Reduction Action Team composed of selected personnel from NAPC, Provincial Legal Office, Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office and the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist.

SECTION 5. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE SECRETARIAT.

The Secretariat of the PPRAT shall have the following duties and functions:

1. Provide administrative support to the PPRAT;
2. Organize and make all necessary arrangements for PPRAT's meetings;
3. Attend PPRAT's meetings;
4. Be the central channel of communication for the PPRAT with other line units of the agency, other government agencies, civic works and the general public; and
5. Perform such other duties as the team may direct, as the circumstances arise.

SECTION 6. PROVISION OF OFFICE SPACE FOR PPRAT.

The Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro shall provide adequate office space within its office building where the Provincial Poverty Reduction Action Team can perform its regular duties and functions.

SECTION 7. FUNDING.

The funding necessary for the implementation of this Executive Order shall be funded out of the required Provincial Government's cash counterpart. This will be used to support the meetings and monitoring activities of the PPRAT, including the reimbursement of transportation expenses of CSO representatives in the PPRAT.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid for any reason, the parts not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations issued by this province which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY.

This ORDER shall take effect immediately.
