



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 98
Series of 2020

**AN ORDER CREATING THE PROVINCIAL CODE TEAM OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO,
DEFINING ITS DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, in view of IATF Resolution No. 63-A, Series of 2020, the proposal of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) for a more expanded tracing, extracting, and isolating strategies for Covid-19 asymptomatic and mild cases including suspect cases was approved. In the furtherance of Prevent-Detect-Isolate-Treat-Recovery strategy of the National Action Plan Phase II, Barangay Coordinated Operations to Defeat Epidemic (Barangay CODE) model was adopted by the National Task Force;

WHEREAS, according to Department of Health (DOH), Coordinated Operations to Defeat Epidemic (CODE) is a response initiative to give support to LGUs with limited capabilities and resources to mitigate localized transmission at the community level through enhanced surveillance strategy and expanded testing capacity.

WHEREAS, as a protocol adopted by the government in its continuing battle to contain the spread of coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid19), CODE Team has to commence active case finding through close coordination between DOH representatives and communities across the country;

WHEREAS, pursuant to RIATF and RTF Joint Resolution No. 23, S. 2020, there is a need to establish Provincial Code Team of Occidental Mindoro. The Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro is likewise mandated to establish its structure and composition;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Governor of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the creation of Provincial CODE Team of Occidental Mindoro, defining its duties and functions, and for other purposes.

Section 1. CREATION AND COMPOSITION. The Provincial CODE Team of Province of Occidental Mindoro is hereby created. It shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Provincial Code Team members shall perform the following roles and responsibilities:

1. Provincial Health Office
 - a. Supervise implementation of PDITR Strategy;
 - b. Provide data analytic for basis of localized/zonal lockdown;
 - c. Provide advisory to LGU on implementation of PDITR strategy;
 - d. Post materials in key strategic areas;
 - e. Conduct micro-town halls;
 - f. Facilitate health facility referral and transfer of cases.
2. PDRRMO/MDRRMOs
 - a. Supervise and monitor the implementation of the localized/zonal lockdown;
 - b. Provide advisory on PDITR strategy.
3. DILG
 - a. Provide advisory to LGU on PDITR Strategy;
 - b. Organize and deploy CTTs;
 - c. Develop Operational Plans.
4. PSWDO/MSWDO
 - a. Provide social amelioration support to the families and individuals.
5. PNP/AFP
 - a. Put barricades/checkpoints;
 - b. Place security personnel in all entry and exit points;
 - c. Deploy security personnel for monitoring.
6. MHO
 - a. Respond to all symptomatic suspect, probable, and confirmed cases;
 - b. Reintegrate to the community those recovered suspect, probable, and confirmed cases;
 - c. Do random community swabbing.

7. Local Epidemiological and Surveillance Units (LESUs)
 - a. Profile suspect, probable, and confirmed Covid-19 cases;
 - b. Identify and list close contacts.
8. Contact Tracing Teams (CTTs)
 - a. Locate, profile, assess, manage, and follow-up close contacts.
9. Barangay Health Emergency Response Teams (BHERTs)
 - a. Conduct home visit and refer suspect and probable contacts to appropriate facilities (TTMFs or hospitals);
 - b. Collect swab samples and send to RT-PCR laboratory for confirmatory testing;
 - c. Reintegrate to the community those recovered suspect, probable, and confirmed cases.

Section 3. SECRETARIAT. The Secretariat of the Provincial CODE Team shall be composed of selected Personnel from the DILG.

Section 4. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE SECRETARIAT.

The Secretariat of the Provincial CODE Team shall have the following duties and functions:

1. Provide administrative support to the Provincial CODE Team;
2. Organize and make all necessary arrangements for the Team's meetings;
3. Attend the Team's meetings;
4. Be the central channel of communication for the Team with other line units of the agency, other government agencies, and the general public; and
5. Perform such other duties as the Team may direct, as the circumstances arise.

Section 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid for any reason, the parts not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

Section 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations issued by this province which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately.
