



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14-A**  
Series of 2023

**AN ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14, SERIES OF 2023, RECONSTITUTING  
THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD OF THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO,  
IDENTIFYING ITS MEMBERS, THEIR DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Article 184 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act 7160) mandates the creation of the Local School Board (LSB);

**WHEREAS**, education stands as one of the core priorities of the Provincial Government, recognizing its importance as a great social equalizer towards a better quality of life and as a building block of developing a culture of excellence;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 14, series of 2023 was issued to reconstitute the Local School Board of the Province of Occidental Mindoro due to the end of term of former LSB members and to include additional members;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to reconstitute the LSB due to change of assignment of a former LSB member;

**WHEREAS**, based on the above premises, the Provincial Government would like to ensure the seamless transition to the new administration including the continuity of the functions and programs of the LSB;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO**, Provincial Governor of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reconstitution of the LSB of the Province of Occidental Mindoro, with the following stipulations:

**Section 1. Composition**

The LSB of the Province of Occidental Mindoro shall be composed of the following:

## **Section 2. Duties and Functions of the LSB**

The LSB shall perform the following functions:

1. Determine, in accordance with the criteria set by the Department of Education, the annual supplementary budgetary needs for the operation and maintenance of public schools within the province, city, or municipality, as the case may be, and the supplementary local cost of meeting such needs, which shall be reflected in the form of an annual school board budget corresponding to its share of the proceeds of the special levy on real property constituting the Special Education Fund and such other sources of revenue as the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA7610) and other laws or ordinances may provide;
2. Authorize the Provincial Treasurer, to disburse funds from the Special Education Fund pursuant to the budget prepared and in accordance with existing rules and regulations;
3. Serve as an advisory committee to the sanggunian concerned on educational matters, such as, but not limited to, the necessity for and the uses of local appropriations for educational purposes; and
4. Recommend changes in the names of public schools within the territorial jurisdiction of the local government unit for enactment by the local sanggunian.

The Department of Education, shall consult the LSB on the appointment of division superintendents, district supervisors, school principals, and other school officials.

## **Section 3. Meetings and Quorum**

- a. The LSB shall meet at least once a month or as often as may be necessary.
- b. Any of the co-chairpersons may call a meeting. A majority of all its members shall constitute a quorum. However, when both co-chairpersons are present in a meeting, the local chief executive concerned, as a matter of protocol, shall be given preference to preside over the meeting. The Division Superintendent shall prepare the budget of the LSB. Such budget shall be supported by programs, projects and activities of the school board for the ensuing fiscal year. The affirmative vote of the majority of all the members shall be necessary to approve the budget.



#### **Section 4. Budget**

The annual school board budget shall give priority to the following:

- a. Construction, repair and maintenance of school buildings and other facilities of public elementary and secondary schools;
- b. Establishment and maintenance of extension classes where necessary; and
- c. Sports activities at the division, district, municipal and barangay levels.

#### **Section 5. Compensation and Renumeration**

The co-chairpersons and members of the provincial school board shall perform their duties as such without compensation or remuneration. Members thereof who are not government officials or employees shall be entitled to necessary traveling expenses and allowances chargeable against the funds of the LSB, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

#### **Section 6. Repealing Clause**

All Executive Orders or issuances issued by the Provincial Government inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

#### **Section 7. Effectivity**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
