



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 27-A**  
Series of 2022

**AN ORDER PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF PROVINCIAL COUNCIL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE (PCGLG) OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO AND REORGANIZATION OF SEAL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE – TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (SGLG – TWG), PROVIDING FOR THEIR FUNCTIONS AND OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 11292 otherwise known as “The Seal of Good Local Governance Act of 2019” institutionalized the Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG) as an award, honor and recognition-based program aimed to boost LGU’s drive to constantly progress and/or sustain their notable performance across various governance areas;

**WHEREAS**, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2022-026, entitled “2022 Seal of Good Local Governance: Pagkilala sa Katapatan at Kahusayan ng Pamahalaang Lokal” provides for the assessment criteria for the SGLG and maintained the “All-in” principle where a local government unit must pass ALL the identified governance areas;

**WHEREAS**, the 2022 SGLG requires an LGU to pass ten governance areas namely: financial administration and sustainability; disaster preparedness; social protection and sensitivity; health compliance and responsiveness; sustainable education; business-friendliness and competitiveness; safety, peace and order; environmental management; tourism, heritage development, culture and arts; and, youth development;

**WHEREAS**, consistent with the law, it shall be the burden of the LGU to show that it qualifies for the Seal. For a province to qualify, at least ten percent (10%) of its component cities and municipalities must be SGLG passers;

**WHEREAS**, to synchronize all actions of the Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro in coordination with concerned offices and agencies and to ensure compliance with the assessment criteria corresponding to the areas aforementioned, the creation of the **PROVINCIAL COUNCIL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE (PCGLG) OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO** and the reorganization of the **SEAL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE – TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (SGLG – TWG)** are necessary;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO**, Governor of the Province of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the **CREATION OF PROVINCIAL COUNCIL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE (PCGLG) OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO** and the **REORGANIZATION OF SEAL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE – TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (SGLG – TWG)**:



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**SECTION 1. COMPOSITION OF THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE (PCGLG) OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO (PGOM).** PCGLG of the PGOM shall be composed of the following members:

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**SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS OF THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE (PCGLG) OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO.** PCGLG of the PGOM shall perform the following functions:

1. Make sure that the Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro is compliant with the SGLG requirements and have met the assessment criteria;
2. Coordinate with concerned agencies throughout the implementation of the SGLG where the participation of the Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro (PGOM) is required;
3. Hold regular meetings to discuss the relevant issues and/or updates and such other important matters pertaining to SGLG;
4. Prepare an evidence-based analysis that the programs, projects, and activities of the PGOM in connection with the governance areas are in accordance with the indicators of good local governance and the objectives and principles of the SGLG;
5. Gather and consolidate data from municipalities relative to their compliance with the SGLG assessment criteria;
6. Ensure that all the data, documents, and requisites for the assessment are complete, reliable, credible and are readily available and accessible upon presentation for review, inspection, verification, or assessment;
7. Keep electronic copies of all related documents for ease of reference and retrieval;
8. Report to the Governor as may be deemed appropriate by the body to provide him with necessary update; and
9. Perform such other functions as are necessary or incidental to properly carry out the purposes of RA No. 11292.

**SECTION 4. FUNCTIONS OF THE SEAL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (SGLG-TWG).** The SGLG – TWG shall perform the duties and functions, as follows:

1. Assist the PCGLG in making sure that the PGOM are compliant with the SGLG requirements and have met the assessment criteria;
2. Attend regular meetings to discuss the relevant issues and/or updates and such other important matters pertaining to SGLG;
3. Assist in the preparation of evidence-based analysis that the programs, projects, and activities of the PGOM in connection with the governance areas are in accordance with the indicators of good local governance and the objectives and principles of the SGLG;
4. Assist in the preparation of documentary requirements for the SGLG Assessment;
5. Gather and consolidate data from municipalities relative to their compliance with the respective SGLG assessment criteria;
6. Keep electronic copies of all related documents for ease of reference and retrieval; and
7. Report to the Chairperson as may be deemed appropriate by the body to provide him with necessary update.

**SECTION 5. ASSESSMENT CRITERIA**

The SGLG – TWG shall be guided by the following governance areas which aim for:

- i. Financial Administration and Sustainability: *Uphold the practice of fiscal discipline and sustainability, and transparency and accountability in the use of public funds;*
- ii. Disaster Preparedness: *Prevent and prepare for disasters, whether natural or human-induced, in order to strengthen their resilience;*
- iii. Social Protection and Sensitivity: *Demonstrate responsiveness to the needs of, and facilitate meaningful engagement with the vulnerable and marginalized sectors of society;*
- iv. Health Compliance and Responsiveness: *set-up, implement, and sustain health policies and programs that would strengthen and promote the well-being, healthy lifestyle, and safety of the public, while ensuring that all individuals, especially the vulnerable, have fair opportunities for better health without causing financial hardship through the organization of an integrated healthcare delivery system;*

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v. Sustainable

Education: *Implement education reforms and programs to support the vision of quality education for all;*

- vi. Business-Friendliness and Competitiveness: *enable pro-competitive policies and interventions, and facilitate ease of doing business, in accordance with the Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act f 2018 (RA 11032);*
- vii. Safe, Peace and Order: *Protect constituents from threats to life and damage to property;*
- viii. Environmental Management: *Safeguard and preserve the integrity of the environment through adaptive social responsibility;*
- ix. Tourism, Heritage Development, Culture and Arts: *Foster the value of sustainable tourism, and nurture culture and heritage; and*
- x. Youth Development: *Stimulate meaningful participation of youth in local governance and nation-building.*

**SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.**

If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid for any reason, the parts not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

**SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE.**

All Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations issued by this province which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
