"AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17-A SERIES OF 2019, UPDATING THE MEMBERS OF THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN, THE SECRETARIAT OF THE PCPC AND THE INTER-AGENCY MONITORING TASK FORCE OF THE PCPC IN THE PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO"

WHEREAS, pursuant to DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2002-121 dated August 5, 2002, LGUs are encouraged to organize their respective Provincial Council for the Protection of Children as per provision of PD 603 as amended and Republic Act 8980;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Council for the Protection of Children shall be responsible in planning and spearheading programs for children in the province with the end view of making the province child friendly;

WHEREAS, to sustain national efforts in the localization of the National Strategic Framework for Plan Development for Children or Child 21, there is a need to make the PCPC functional;

WHEREAS, the problem of illegal drugs has to be addressed much more effectively to ensure community peace harmony;

WHEREAS, there is a need to update the roster of the Provincial Council for the Protection of Children, the Secretariat of the PCPC and the Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force of the PCPC;

Section 2. Functions and Responsibilities. The PCPC shall exercise the following functions, viz:

- Formulate Plans, Programs and Policies for Children that are gender fair, culturally relevant and responsive to the needs of diverse groups of children from 0 to below 18 years of age;
- 2. Prepare AWFP for children and recommend appropriations to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;
- Provide coordinative linkages with other agencies and institutions in the planning, monitoring and evaluation of plans for children;
- 4. Provide technical assistance and recommend financial support to the Municipal and Barangay Council for the Protection of Children;
- 5. Establish and maintain data base on children;
- Recommend local legislations promoting child survival, protection, participation and development, especially on the quality of television shows, media prints and coverage, which are detrimental to children and with appropriate funding;
- Conduct capability programs to enhance knowledge and skill in handling children's program;
- 8. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the program and submit quarterly status reports to the RSCWC;
- 9. Foster education of every child;
- Advocate for the establishment and maintenance of playgrounds, day care centers and other facilities necessary for child and youth development;
- Assist children in need of special protection and refer cases filed against child abusers to proper agencies/institutions;
- 12. Document barangay Best Practices on Children; and
- 13. Perform such other functions as provided for in the ECCD and other child related laws;

The **Secretariat of the Provincial Council for the Protection of Children** shall exercise the following functions, viz:

- 1. Prepare reports and minutes of the meeting;
- 2. Prepare action plan with the corresponding budget proposal;
- 3. Ensure the SP Ordinances and other Issuances concerning children are in place;
- 4. Prepare Accomplishment Report; and
- Submit all the needed documents to the Regional Inter-Agency Monitoring task Force as required by law.

The Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force of the Provincial Council for the Protection of Children shall exercise the following functions, viz:

1. Review required documents from the MCPC;

- Review and validate the consolidated reports of the MIMTF on the functionality of BCPC;
- 3. Evaluate/rate the MCPC based on the documents submitted and standard rating provided in the DILG MC No. 2008-126 dated August 21, 2008;
- 4. Confer with the concerned municipal mayor on the outcome of the evaluation;
- 5. Come up with the recommended actions; and
- 6. Using LCPC Form 2-A and 2-B, submit report in the soft and hard copies to the DILG Provincial Office.

Section 3. Source of Funds. Financial requirements for the activities and projects of the Provincial Council for the Protection of Children shall be chargeable against 20% Development Fund of the Province subject to usual auditing and accounting rules.

Section 4. Effectivity- This Order shall take effect immediately.
