



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 16

Series of 2019

“PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE SPECIAL DRUG EDUCATION CENTER (PSDEC) AND ORGANIZATION OF PROVINCIAL SPECIAL DRUG EDUCATION CENTER TEAM (PSDECT) OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO, DEFINING ITS DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”

WHEREAS, Section 46 of Republic Act No. 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002 provides that, “With the assistance of the Board, the DILG, the National Youth Commission, and the DSWD shall establish in each of its provincial/municipal office a Special Drug Education Center (SDEC) for Out-of-School-Youths and Street Children.”;

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the above-mentioned provision, the Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB) promulgated Board Resolution No. 1, Series of 2003, providing guidelines on the establishment and operationalization of the Special Drug Education Center (SDEC) and organization of the SDEC Team;

WHEREAS, SDEC is a community based facility which serves as a venue and the SDEC Team will be an organization in promoting preventive and developmental services for the Out-of-School-Youths (OSY) and the Street Children;

WHEREAS, SDEC Team shall promote programs for drug abuse prevention with the end in view of educating the Out-of-School-Youths (hereinafter referred as “OSY”) and Street Children regarding the pernicious effects of drug abuse thereby contributing to their development as self-reliant and socially responsible individuals;

NOW THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, Governor of Occidental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

Section I. Composition. There is hereby established a Provincial Special Drug Education Center (PSDEC) and organized a Provincial Special Drug Education Center Team (PSDECT) of Occidental Mindoro in the Office of the Governor, hereinafter referred as the “PSDEC” and “PSDECT” to be composed of the following:

Section II. Duties and Functions. The PSDEC Team shall have the following duties and functions:

- a. Develop and implement programs and services on drug abuse prevention among OSY and street children and coordinate, integrate, and utilize related activities or services of other agencies' programs and activities which may include the following components provided for in the Dangerous Drugs Board Regulation No. 1, Series of 2003, viz:
 1. Advocacy and Social Preparation;
 2. Technical Assistance and Capacity Building for Implementation;
 3. Networking and Resource Generation;
 4. Data Banking and Documentation;
 5. Monitoring and Evaluations;
 6. Service Delivery; and
 7. Replication
- b. Operate and manage the PSDEC accordingly to establish guidelines set by the DSWD;
- c. Provide the facilities, funds, personnel supplies, materials and equipment necessary in the management of the center and implementation of drug abuse prevention activities;
- d. Identify target clients and manage their case;
- e. Ensure that the PSDEC complies with standards developed on the operation of the center as approved by the DDB;
- f. Organize and mobilize volunteers to assist in the implementation of drug abuse prevention program in coordination with the PSWDO;
- g. Conduct regular monitoring and evaluation of the PSDEC following the standard set, including documentation of drug abuse prevention program; and
- h. Submit quarterly/annual reports to the DDB, PSWDO, and DILG.



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Section III. Funds. The budgetary requirements shall be charged to any available local funds of the Provincial Government as provided in Section 51, Article 6 of Republic Act No. 9165, and may also tap and/or request, in coordination with concerned national offices, donations from PAGCOR, share in gaming and amusement centers, and private sectors' contributions or other sources generated from fund-raising activities.

Section IV. Repealing Clause. All Executive Orders, Memoranda, Circulars, Letters of Instructions and other issuances that are found to be inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section V. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
