



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 34-A

Series of 2019

“AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 34 SERIES OF 2019”

WHEREAS, due to the outbreak of African Swine Fever (ASF) in some parts of the country, Executive Order No. 34 series of 2019 imposing temporary ban on the entry of live domestic and wild pigs, pork meat and its products into the Province of Occidental Mindoro was issued by the Provincial Governor of this Province on September 19, 2019;

WHEREAS, since then and up to this date, the Island of Mindoro composed of the Provinces of Occidental Mindoro and Oriental Mindoro, remains ASF Free;

WHEREAS, in fact, the Province of Oriental Mindoro issued Executive Order No. 230 allowing the entry of live hogs, pork and pork-based products raised, slaughtered and manufactured in Occidental Mindoro;

WHEREAS, it becomes imperative for the Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro to amend some sections of Executive Order No. 34 to allow the entry of live hogs, pork and pork-based products coming from the Province of Oriental Mindoro provided that these are accompanied with proper shipping documents and the pork and pork-based products must be sourced from NMIS “AA” accredited slaughterhouses or abattoirs.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO B. GADIANO, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law as Provincial Governor, do hereby promulgate this Executive Order:

Section I. Amendment to Section III.- Section III of Executive Order No. 34 series of 2019 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section III. Implementing guidelines on the transport of live domestic and wild pigs and their products including pork meat, processed pork meat, pork meat by products and semen into the Province of Occidental Mindoro:

- a. All live domestic and wild pigs and their products sourced from other provinces and foreign countries are totally banned and prohibited in the Province of Occidental Mindoro ***except those live hogs, pork and pork-based products raised, slaughtered and processed in Oriental Mindoro, which must be accompanied with proper shipping documents. Moreover, said pork and pork based products must be sourced from NMIS “AA” accredited slaughterhouses or abattoirs as per FDA Advisory No. 2019-303.***
